

Call meeting to order and opening prayer

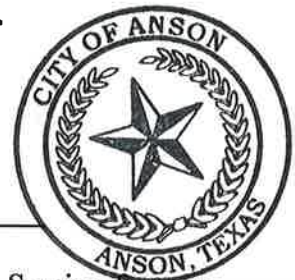
- A. Presentation from Citizens. No formal action may be taken. (Limit 5 minutes per spokesperson).
