

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.999959 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of City of Anson.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.999959 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.960113 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.999995 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for City of Anson from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that City of Anson may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that City of Anson is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 28, 2026 AT 6:00 PM AT Anson City Hall, 1301 Commercial Ave, Anson, TX.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, City of Anson is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Anson City Council of City of Anson at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by City of Anson last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by City of Anson this year.

Total tax levy on all properties	\$1,281,409	\$1,336,115	increase of \$54,706, or 4.27%
